The Rheinhessen region, located west and south of the Rhein river, is the largest of the 13 German wine regions and produces mostly white wine from a number of grape varieties, including Müller-Thurgau, Riesling and Silvaner. Rheinhessen is a vast countryside with sloping terrain largely devoted to vineyards and is often referred to as the "land of a thousand hills."

Our *Weinkellerei* KREUSCH range includes both Qualitäts- and Prädikatswein. The Riesling Qualitätswein is packaged in the classic, antique-brown Schlegel flute and the trio of Prädikatswein, in the ever- popular royal blue bottle – both with BVS closure.

* Riesling	10.5 - 11%	26 gr/l	7.2 gr/l	Fruity and refreshing, offering crisp green apple flavors, notes of fresh peach and pear with a solid core of zesty lemon-lime acidity, which provides nice structure. The wine has moderate intensity with good balance and an off-dry, yet fruity finish.

Our Prädikatswein range are delightfully fruity wines covering the trilogy of the main quality levels of the Prädikat classification. Each is produced from select varietals, including Silvaner, Kerner, Faberrebe, Huxelrebe, Ortega and Optima. These relatively early-ripening varieties – so-called Bouquet varietals, as they produce wines with a distinctive floral bouquet and an alluring spiciness.

It's very appealing and easy drinking as it delivers ripeness and concentration. The semi-sweet finish is long, with notes of mineral and hint of ginger and spice.
*	Spätlese	8.5 – 9.0%	60 gr/l	6.5 gr/l	Golden straw in color, this wine offers a lovely floral scent of fresh blossoms. On the palate it offers a potpourri of rich, ripe fruit notes, including Bosc pear, mango, apricots and yellow peach. It's very appealing and easy drinking as it delivers ripeness and concentration. The sweet finish is long and unwavering, with hints of mineral and spice.
*	Auslese	8.5 – 9.0%	77 gr/l	6.5 gr/l	Golden straw in color, this wine offers a wonderfully spicy, floral scent. On the palate it displays rich, tropical fruit flavors, including tangerine, dried apricot, mango, and pineapple. It's very appealing and easy drinking as it delivers superb ripeness and concentration. The finish is long and unwavering, with hints of mineral and spice and plenty of sweetness, but remains nicely balanced.
